February 2024 – Inspired by the concept of *Reciprocity*, encouraging dialogue, exchange and encounter, La Residencia, A Belmond Hotel, is thrilled to announce that yet another year it will offer the unique opportunity for artists from all over the globe to apply for an art residency, in collaboration with Galleria Continua, at Deia's intimate mountainside enclave.

The art infused property repeats an **open call** and invites artists of all disciplines, ages and nationalities to join Mallorca's creative scene and take part in one of the **two-month residencies** programmes :

1st residency - May - June 2024 2nd residency - July-August 2024 3rd residency - September- October 2024

The call for applications **begins on February 6th and closes on March 6th**. The notification of the results will take place on the 31<sup>st</sup> of March.

The three artists in Residencia will be selected by a prestigious committee:

Artists are invited to **create an artwork** that will be exhibited in the most appropriate space on the premises during the season. The residency includes **accommodation** at La Residencia or close by, a monthly living grant of €500 and a **production grant** of €5000 per artist.

Artists will have the unique opportunity to work in a studio bathed in natural light, open to the view of passer-by. This setup will **encourage interactions, shared experiences, and collaborative activities** with hotel guests, creating a dynamic environment that enhances the overall artistic process. The artists will have the possibility to give renumerated art classes to hotel's guests with a creative calling.

Applications must be submitted in English by March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Any that are incomplete or do not adhere to the above requisites will be disregarded.
